Central Energy Trust Wildbase Recovery is a world class rehabilitation centre for native wildlife recovering from illness or injury. The centre provides shelter and care to a range of native wildlife during their recovery after treatment at Massey University's Wildbase Hospital.

The centre is made up of fourteen specially designed rehabilitation aviaries for patients, a walkthrough aviary housing tuatara and a variety of resident native birds, two breeding aviaries for the endangered whio (blue duck) and pāteke (brown teal), and the Powerco Education Centre.

Every animal at Central Energy Trust Wildbase Recovery is an ambassador for their species and the perils facing them in the wild. We provide the community with a conservation education experience like no other. Locals, visitors, schools and community organisations have the opportunity to see conservation in action - and learn how they can make a difference to the future of New Zealand's native wildlife.
