DELIVERY TYPES

A **Core Visit** is a standard visit to our centre. It includes a tour of the centre. Patient stories including their diagnosis, treatment and recovery journey. Time to explore the Powerco Education Centre and get hands-on with conservation focused activities.

Big Picture Programme has three parts;

- Visit to Schools: In school we set the scene for what we do and how we fit within wider conservation in New Zealand;
- 2. Centre Visit: Students explore our centre, delving into our core visit. Students gain a deep appreciation for conservation.
- 3. Follow-up Visit: Time in school where students share their learning or tangible outcomes.

This visit type is focused towards primary and intermediate schools.

- The centre is fully bilingual in English and te reo Māori.
- While we have limited numbers in the centre, groups of children can rotate through the centre and the other activities in the Esplanade.
